One building, with an elevator, is limited to persons 62 and over, and other buildings are 2 story walk-ups. Applicants must be 62 years of age or older . Senior Property: <u>Naperville Elderly Homes</u> , Naperville, IL Unit Type: 1- Bedroom Units Description: Naperville Elderly Homes is a privately owned and managed senior living community that offers affordable rents. <p>Senior Property: <u>Woodridge Horizons</u>, Woodridge, IL</p> <p>Unit Types: One Bedroom Units</p> <p>Description: A Senior Citizen complex owned and managed by the Alden Network. Applicants must be 62 years or older.</p>	Woodridge Horizons 1-Bedroom Unit	100

<p>Social Services Agency Property: <u>Finley Supportive Housing</u>, Lombard, IL</p> <p>Unit Types: Studio, 1-Bedroom and 2-Bedroom Units</p> <p>Description: Finley Supportive Housing, run by <u>Trinity Services</u>, is a privately owned and managed property that offers housing units within a three-story apartment building for people with special needs, i.e. disabilities that impair their ability to live independently without support services. All tenants must have incomes less than 50 percent of the average median income.</p>	Finley Supportive Studio Unit	150

<p>Social Services Agency Property: <u>Olympus Place</u>, Naperville, IL</p> <p>Unit Types: 1-Bedroom and 2-Bedroom Units</p> <p>Description: Olympus Place offers subsidized, supportive-housing, provided by <u>DuPage PADS</u>, for individuals, families and veterans who are permanently disabled, have been homeless (per HUD definition) and meet program eligibility. Residents must meet the following criteria: 1.) A <u>permanent documented disability</u> due to a physical or mental condition or addiction; 2.) <u>Documented as homelessness</u> of one current year or longer or four separate episodes within the past three years; 3.) The ability to <u>live independently</u> in the community without medical supervision; and 4.) Willingness to <u>pay 30% of income towards rent</u>. <p>Social Service Agency Property: <u>Trinity-Landings on Villa</u>, Villa Park, IL</p> <p>Unit Types: Studio and 2-Bedroom Units</p> <p>Description: The Landings on Villa, run by Trinity Services, offers apartment units intended for people with mental illness or physical disabilities. To qualify, residents must have a household income that is less than 50 percent of the median family income determined by HUD and must undergo a criminal background check through the Illinois Department of Human Services.</p>	Trinity Landings on Villa Studio Unit	100

<p>Social Service Agency Property: <u>Trinity Alton Court</u>, Naperville, IL Unit Types: Group Living for 4 single men in one home Description: Trinity Alton Court, run by Trinity Services, is a CILA (Community-Integrated Living Arrangement) available for <u>4 single males</u> and serves those with developmental disabilities and/or mental health needs. Each home is staffed by independent living counselors who support the male residents in maintaining the home and participating in community life. In some homes, staff provide support on an intermittent, as-needed basis. Residents share household duties to the extent possible and appropriate.</p>	Trinity_AC Alton Court	25
<p>Social Service Agency Property: <u>Trinity Turtle Cove</u>, Naperville, IL Unit Types: Group Living for 4 single women in one home Description: Trinity Turtle Cove, run by Trinity Services, is a CILA (Community-Integrated Living Arrangement) available for <u>4 single females</u> and serves those with developmental disabilities and/or mental health needs. The home is staffed by independent living counselors who support the female residents in maintaining the home and participating in community life. In some homes, staff provide support on an intermittent, as-needed basis. Residents share household duties to the extent possible and appropriate.</p>	Trinity_TC Turtle Cove	25
